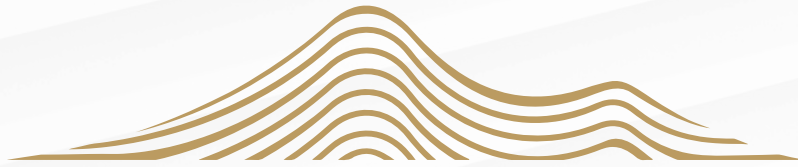

# CARRINGTON ESTATE

*Northland is the birthplace of New Zealand wine, with Reverend Samuel Marsden planting the first vines there in 1819. Just under 200 years later Karikari Estate Vineyard has opened its doors to become New Zealand's northernmost winery located on the beautiful Karikari Peninsula in Doubtless Bay.*



The first vines were planted in 1998, with the production of its first vintage in 2003.

The estate has 13 hectares of vines producing five varieties: Chardonnay, Merlot, Pinotage, Syrah, and Tannat. Three hectares have been planted in 2021, which include more Chardonnay, Syrah, and Pinot Gris. Furthermore, 1.1ha of Sauvignon Blanc was planted at the end of 2022.

Northland's regional climate produces rich, ripe examples of these varieties.

Karikari Estate's philosophy is to ensure the best quality of the region's terroir. This is achieved through vineyard management, traditional winemaking techniques, and a dedicated local workforce.

This philosophy can be recognised from the winery's first vintage of 2003 until now, with numerous medals being attained from the major New Zealand wine shows and wine critics.

Our Winemaker, Alan Collinson, has vast experience making wine from Far North Grapes since 1998, completing 20+ years in Northland and one year in France. He joined the Karikari Estate team in 2012, where he has continued to enhance the Far North as a quality wine-producing region.

# Fact Sheet

## Carrington Estate

- Located on the Karikari Peninsula.
- Carrington Estate is 30 nautical miles from North Cape.
- It is a 3,000-acre estate, farm, and vineyard.
- The stone walls around the Estate were built with stone from the Carrington Quarry and local volcanic stones.
- Before Carrington Estate purchased the property, the land was overgrown with gorse, 4m Tea tree and bush.

## Location

- Karikari Beach has up to 15m high sand dunes.
- Karikari means 'windy-windy' in Māori.
- Houhora Harbour has commercial green lip mussel farms.
- Mt Pwheke is at the end of Karikari Beach and clearly visible from all areas of Carrington Estate.
- The Māori name Pwheke means 'Octopus' in English.
- On the southwest side of Pwheke are approximately 30 hectares of locally owned Pacific Oyster farms.
- Of the 22 world records for the striped marlin, 16 were caught in the waters off the Karikari Cape.

## The Estate Complex

- The Estate has ten lodge rooms and 12 villas.
- All the lodge buildings are connected with covered verandas for comfort.
- The restaurant can seat approximately 44 people comfortably inside.
- The wood beams in the restaurant are made from Northland Macrocarpa.
- The large fireplace in the restaurant was built with Kaeo field stones.
- There is a classic Barton and McGill pool table in the lounge.
- The library has a guest computer with complimentary internet access.
- The predominant wood around the Estate is Rimu.
- Carrington Estate has three helicopter landing pads located opposite the tennis courts.
- Carrington Estate has a conference room that can accommodate 90 people theatre-style
- The conference building has a contemporary Digital projector projects a 2.5m by 3m image.

# Fact Sheet

## Karikari Estate Winery

- Karikari Estate is New Zealand's northernmost vineyard and winery.
- The tiles on the winery roof are imported from Portugal.
- The winery design is Tuscan style and with Palladian arches.
- The vineyard has a planted area of 12.8 Hectares of grapes and is situated 3km from the Pacific Ocean.
- The grapes were first planted in 1998. The first vintage produced 18,000 bottles of wine in 2003.
- The vine rows are all oriented 10 degrees east of north, allowing maximum sun exposure daily.
- We do a mixture of spur pruning and cane pruning, all in the vertical shoot positioning (VSP).
- Karikari Vineyard is a member of the NZ Sustainable Wine Growers Association.
- The natural ocean breezes, and the Karikari hills' anabatic winds lead to a healthy vineyard.
- One barrel holds 300 bottles of wine.
- Karikari Estate uses a combination of French American oak and Hungarian.
- The wine-making equipment is imported from Italy and France.
- The wine-making tanks were manufactured in NZ and are jacketed with a computerised glycol temperature control system.
- The first bottles were released in 2004. They were Chardonnay and a blend popularly called 'Silver Cloud.' (Chardonnay, Semillon Viognier).





# Fact Sheet

## Golf Course

- The Estate has a 100-acre USGA specification golf course.
- The tees and greens are all sand-based and sub-drained.
- We use brown top-bent grass on the greens.
- The signature tree on the golf course is the Pohutukawa.
- Kikuyu grass on the fairways and tees.
- The golf course is fully irrigated with a computerised rainbird irrigation system.
- The 14th hole is 605m par 5 (one of the longest in the country).
- The golf course is 6,633m long, par 72
- The Estate has 22 electric IQ club cars.
- A tunnel goes under the road from the golf course to the vineyard and winery.

## Environment and Wildlife

- Carrington Estate actively works to control possums and land-based predators such as feral cats, stoats, and rats.
- 900 acres of restored native wetlands.
- There are wild pigs on the Peninsula.
- There are large populations of freshwater eel in the ponds on the wetlands.
- The largest eel caught from Carrington Estate weighed 19kg.
- Carrington has primarily used native NZ trees and plants to landscape the Estate.
- The eucalyptus (gum trees) were planted approximately 30 years ago.
- The large palm trees on the property were transplanted and weighed an average of 18 tonnes each.
- There are over 6,000 Pohutukawa trees on the golf course, farm, and vineyard.
- Carrington Farms actively works to eliminate all gorse and pampas grass.

## Birds of the wetlands include

Dotterels - (Endangered species) Bittern, Black Swan, Canada Geese, Kingfisher, Grey Duck, Mallard Duck, Paradise Shelduck, Pukeko, White Faced Heron.

## Saltwater birds include

Pied Stilt, Oyster Catcher, Spur-winged Plover, Eastern Bar-tailed Godwit, Caspian Tern, White Fronted Tern, Eastern Little Tern, Red-Billed Gull, Black-Backed Gull.

Carrington's tournament quality, 18-hole golf course, designed by Matt Dye, is surrounded by sweeping vistas of the Pacific Ocean and the vineyards of Karikari Estate, the northernmost winery in New Zealand.

### **\* RED**

#### **Karikari Estate Pinotage**

*Deep colour and the richness of red fruit aromas with gamey flavours and tannin structure. Cellaring for 5 - 7 years after the vintage date is recommended.*

#### **Karikari Estate Syrah**

*It is made in a lighter style and has aromas of light red fruits, spice and pepper combined with a smooth, inviting finish. Made to last. Cellaring for 3 - 5 years after the vintage date is recommended.*

#### **Karikari Estate Toa Iti**

*Blend of 50% Merlot, 40% Cabernet Franc and 10% Tannat Dark red fruit and well-integrated smoky tannins. Has a smooth entry with a sweet fruit burst finish. The palate is full, with rich tannins and plenty of structure.*

#### **Karikari Estate Hell Hole**

*A light blend of 75% Merlot and 25% Cabernet Franc.*

*The nose displays dried fruit and herbal characters, with subtle hints of toffee and caramel. The wine is off-dry and has an extended tannin finish.*

#### **Calypso Merlot**

*Displays the magical aroma of juicy dark forest fruits, plums, and prunes. The combination makes for a rich tannin and dry finish.*

#### **Kely's Pinot Noir**

*Aromas and flavours of dark red berries, spiced cherry raspberry, and baking spices of cinnamon and vanilla. Balanced, even, and lengthy on the palate with finely integrated tannins, medium acidity, and a core fruit flavours reflecting the nose.*

#### **Kely's Merlot**

*Displays a wonderful aroma of dark forest fruits, liquorice, leather, and plums. Also, has a full, firm palate and lingering tannins.*

### \* **WHITE**

#### **Karikari Estate Chardonnay**

*Full-bodied, barrel fermented and aged style with generous aromas of stone fruit and toasty oak. It is rich-flavoured and oily in texture with an extended finish.*

#### **Calypso Sauvignon Blanc**

*A fresh bouquet of grapefruit, floral and tropical aromas. The palate offers citrus and hints of passionfruit with a refreshing, crisp finish.*

#### **Calypso Pinot Gris**

*Floral bouquet with fresh apples, hints of stone fruit and spice, in a fresh, off-dry flavour. Best enjoyed slightly chilled.*

#### **Calypso Chardonnay**

*Made in the easy-drinking, lighter-bodied style, giving fresh citrus aromas supple flavour. With mineral hints leaving with a divine, dry finish.*

### \* **ROSE**

#### **Calypso Rosé**

*Lightly pressed Merlot and Chardonnay have produced this salmon-coloured Calypso Rose. It has subtle red berry fruit aroma and flavour with an off-dry finish.*

### \* **SPARKLING**

#### **Sparkling Rose**

*Semi-sweet style with a delicate fruity nose and elegant bubbles.*

### \* **FORTIFIED WINE**

#### **Karikari Estate Port (Off-dry)**

*Nutty caramel with wood spice aromas. Sweet, dried fruit and raisin taste, leading to a warm finish.*

# Notice Loss of or Damage to Guests' Property

*Our attention is drawn to the following extracts of the: Innkeepers Act 1962, New Zealand*

## **Section 8**

Monetary limit of liability, where an innkeeper is liable as an innkeeper for the loss of or damage to any property brought to the inn, his liability to any one guest shall not exceed \$300 in respect of any one article, or \$1,200 in the aggregate, unless the guest proves that—

- (a) the property was stolen, lost, or damaged through the default, neglect, or wilful act of the innkeeper or his servant; or
- (b) The property was deposited by or on behalf of the guest expressly for safe custody with the innkeeper or with a servant of his authorised or appearing to be authorised for the purpose, and was if so, required by the innkeeper or that servant, in a container fastened or sealed by the depositor; or
- (c) at a time after the guest had arrived at the inn, either the property was offered for deposit as foresaid and the innkeeper or his servant refused to receive it, or the guest or another guest acting on his behalf wished so to offer the property but, through the default of the innkeeper or his servant, was unable to do so.
